ABSTRACT

The risk of negligence is very high in surgery, if the implementation is not in accordance with the established work system guidelines. The Surgical Safety Checklist is implemented to reduce negligence in surgery, but in implementing the compliance of officers in filling out the Surgical Safety Checklist it is still relatively low. The aim of this study was to determine the relationship between the Supervision of the Head of the Room and Nurse Compliance.

The research design was correlation analytic. The independent variable of the research was the supervision of the head of the room and the dependent was the compliance of the nurses. The study population was all surgical nurses at the Surgical Installation of Sidoarjo General Hospital, consisting of 52 nurses. Samples were taken using proportional random sampling technique as many as 48 respondents. Data were collected using a questionnaire instrument and tested with the Spearman Rho test.

The results showed that almost half of the respondents stated that the supervision of the head of the room was quite good, as many as 22 respondents (45.8%). Most of the respondents comply with the implementation of the surgical safety checklist as many as 36 respondents (75%).

The results of the Spearman rho test showed a value of $\rho = 0.000$ with $\alpha = 0.05$, this shows that the value of $\rho = 0.000 < \alpha = 0.05$ then H0 is rejected so that there is a relationship between Head of Room Supervision and compliance in carrying out surgical safety checklist in the Hospital Surgery Installation Sidoarjo.

The supervision of the head of the room that is carried out properly can foster enthusiasm and good work motivation, the performance displayed by nurses is getting better, one of which is by complying with procedures for implementing the Surgical safety checklist according to predetermined SOP.
